§ Conference Location

The GOMA Conference is located at the Nuremberg Conference Center (NCC) Ost on the grounds of the Nuremberg Messe, in Room Shanghai on Level 3.

NCC is located on the east side of the Nuremberg Messe grounds. For a map of the Messe grounds and NCC Ost, please visit this site:

From the U-Bahn (local underground train) station, "Messe" it is about a 10 minute walk around the perimeter of the grounds to the NCC.

§ Transportation

The U-Bahn serves the Messe from the Central Station (Hauptbahnhof). From the Central Station, take line U1 (blue) in the direction of Langwasser Süd. The Messe is the 6th stop, or the second stop after the train emerges from underground.
